As we approach the month of November, I want to say a few words about our 234th Annual Meeting that was held on October 24th. We has 18 Churches represented with a total of 75 people present! We had two guest speakers, Clay Leonard from the Baptist Childrens Homes of NC, and Dr. Todd Martin from the Shallowford Foundation. Flat Rock, established in 1783, is known as the "Mother Church" of many of our surrounding Baptist Churches and a Charter Member who helped organize the Yadkin Baptist Association in 1790, hosted our Annual Meeting. And host they did!! When the meeting was over, everyone was invited to their renovated Fellowship Hall for a "mini feast!" Thanks to Pastor and Mrs. Tomlin and the members of Flat Rock for being such gracious hosts.

In November, we are reminded of upcoming Annual events. Our Baptist State Convention is always in November. This year the Convention is November 4th and 5th at the Koury Convention Center in Greensboro.

Election Day is always the first Tuesday of November every other year. This year is a Presidential election year, which occurs every four years. Because of the sacrifice of our men and women in uniform who fought for our liberty and freedoms that we hold so dear in America, please exercise your right and privilege to vote.

The fourth Thursday in November is recognized as Thanksgiving Day. This is a day set aside to give THANKS to our Heavenly Father for His Many Blessings. As the song says, "Count your many blessings, name them one by one, and it will surprise you what the Lord hath done!"

Our Association has given over \$100,000 directly to Hurricane Helene relief efforts!!!! This is in addition to contributions to the State Missions Offering. Our Churches have also responded with over \$50,000 of in-kind donations for the relief efforts by giving bottled water, can foods, baby food, diapers, and wipes, cleaning supplies, wheel barrows, tools, mops, brooms, shovels, tarps, space heaters, propane gas tanks, charcoal grills, blankets, towels and wash cloths, sweaters, coats, gloves, pants and shirts, shoes and boots, OTC medications and personal hygiene items!!!! Our Association responds above and beyond when the need arises. To date, the YBA has taken 4 fully loaded trailers to the Western part of NC to give out supplies to those in need. On one of our trips, we also grilled 250 hot dogs and gave Activity bags (coloring books, crayons, toys, stuffed animals and candy) to the Children, as well as, giving out Cotton Candy, Snow Cones and popcorn to the folks who came through the drive thru distribution. Currently, we have 2 loaded trailers awaiting word on where the need is the greatest.

Many of our Churches have also responded by going to the devastated areas to help with chains saw work, mud outs, drilling a well, working on the Feeding Unit and providing meals in many local communities.

Our November Ministers Meeting will be Tuesday, November 19th at 11:30 a.m. at the YBA Office. Our December Meeting will be for Minister, Spouse and at home Children on Tuesday, December 3rd at 6:00 p.m. at Forbush Baptist Church. We will have a delicious meal, entertainment (a small Jazz band and lots of audience participation!!!) games with everyone getting a gift and lots of fellowship!!!

Our (new) Associational Administrative Assistant has now been with us one year!! Our Personnel Committee, Finance Committee, Executive Council and made a good decision to recommend Brenda (Chandler) for the position! We wish our former Administrative Assistant, Brenda (Garner) much happiness as she enjoys her retirement after serving our Association for 42 years. Last I heard, she was "just a rocking" in her rocking chair!!!



### **ANNUAL MEETING 2024 ON MISSION TOGETHER**

Messengers and guests can now register for the 2024 N.C. Baptist annual meeting, which will take place on Nov. 4-5 in Greensboro. Read the story below to learn more.

Online registration for the 2024 N.C. Baptist annual meeting is now open.

Messengers and guests may visit <u>ncannualmeeting.org</u> to register for the meeting, which is scheduled for Nov. 4-5 at the Koury Convention Center in Greensboro.

Because this year's meeting coincides with the U.S. elections on Nov. 5, the annual meeting features a condensed schedule on Tuesday, with sessions ending at 4 p.m. Messengers and attendees have also been encouraged to vote early.

To register for this year's annual meeting, messengers should use a unique, personal email address, and they will need their church's ID and PIN numbers. Guests will also have the opportunity to register by selecting the "visitor" option on the registration page.

A letter containing registration instructions, along with ID and PIN numbers, has been mailed to N.C. Baptist churches. Churches that have an email address on file with the state convention were also sent an email with instructions and their ID and PIN numbers on Sept. 16.

Any churches who did not receive a unique church PIN or ID — which is not the same as a church's SBC ID — are encouraged to contact the state convention at (800) 395-5102 or (919) 459-5555.

Registrants will receive a ticket for the annual meeting via email after completing their registration. If registrants do not receive their ticket within an hour, they are encouraged to check their email spam folder.

An additional email with the ticket will be sent just prior to the annual meeting. Attendees must present their ticket when they arrive and check in at the annual meeting in November.

The theme of this year's annual meeting is "On Mission Together" and is based on Matthew 20:26-28, which says, "whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first among you must be your slave; just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Messengers and guests will have several opportunities to reflect on being on mission together— especially during the meeting's breakout sessions, times of worship and during the N.C. Baptist and IMB Sending Celebration taking place on Monday night.
